- Certificate is 9 credit hours.
- \$580/credit hour for the 2025-26 academic year, \$5,220 for entire program.
- Applications accepted beginning July 1, 2024. Applications will be reviewed beginning in late Fall 2024.
- Class is hybrid-online. First week of summer class is asynchronous, the second week is a synchronous intensive, with the rest of the class being asynchronous.
- First class begins Summer 2025, with the next classes beginning in Fall 2025 and Spring 2026 respectively. Fall and Spring courses are synchronous.

The deadline to apply is May 1, 2025.
