Instructions to site PIs:

- After obtaining IRB approval, please reach out to nursing units therapy directors ICU and ER staff to determine best means of distributing voluntary anonymous electronic surveys with your specific site code.
- Please reach out to any rehabilitation center your system discharge to- this could be an acute rehabilitation facility, a SNF or LTAC, home health care or outpatient rehabilitation provider. They do not have to be affiliated with your center other than accepting your trauma patients post discharge.

FAQS:

- What should be included when distributing the survey to your staff?
 - Introductory letter (if required by your IRB)
 - Your site may create their own introduction letter and include this in an email when distributing the REDCap survey link. If you have any questions on creating this, please reach out to the RCHSD PI or the RCHSD study coordinator.
 - Your site code (provided by RCHSD research team)
 - REDCap survey link
- What is the purpose of this study?
 - The purpose of the study is to determine whether there are differences in attitudes regarding victims of violence based on the exposure to such patients; type of trauma center; type of rehabilitation setting; and role of providers; support services for staff, victims and families; and how all of these variables may influence provider perception and comfort level with caring for this patient population.
- Will our institution or staff be identified?
 - No, institutions and individuals will not be identified. The site code will serve to group responses but will not be identifiable.
- How long will this take to complete?
 - This survey takes about approximately 10 minutes for staff and 15 minutes for trauma center or rehab center director/representative. This can be done on or off the clock as preferred by each site.
